(Hint : A good place to begin is in and around the market square, we have listed the images in order as much as possible)

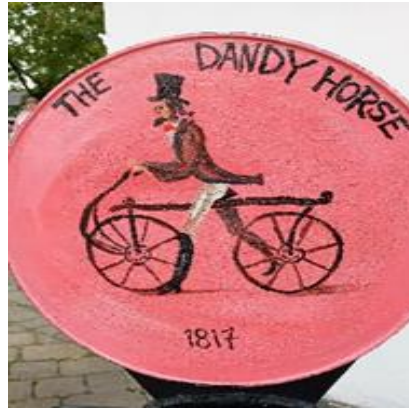
